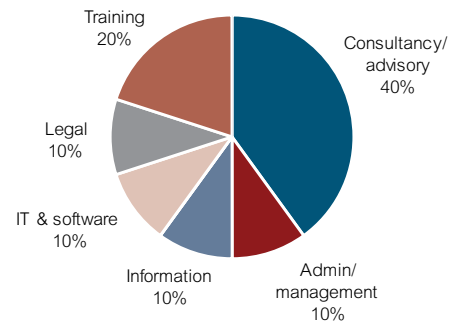
OVERVIEW

CASE STUDY 1: BorsodChem MCHZ, lead registrant support

Client requested ReachSpektrum to act as technical secretariat and supporting consulting company in the role of the lead registrant under REACH. ReachSpektrum offered BorsodChem MCHZ to become a SFF, conducted SIEF management and election of the lead registrant. ReachSpektrum then provided literature search evaluation, supported preparation of dossier, coordinated work with partners and ensured communication within SIEF and potential members of joint submission. The registration was finished in October 2010, well before the deadline and accepted by ECHA as complete. All members of joint submissions successfully submitted their individual dossiers (partly pre-created by ReachSpektrum) in time.

CASE STUDY 2: Ministry of Industry and Trade of the Czech Republic, impact assessment study

In 2008, ReachSpektrum provided, at the request of the Ministry of Industry and Trade, an impact research study on GHS Regulation against costs of manufacturers producing chemical substances and preparations/mixtures according to the GHS Regulation.

CASE STUDY 3: MAGNA Interiors and Exteriors (Bohemia), REACH status analysis

The client from the automotive industry with three manufacturing sites in the Czech Republic, asked ReachSpektrum to analyse its role under the REACH Regulation, to determine its obligations and prepare follow-up actions based on the analysis. The work of ReachSpektrum consisted of complex procedures. During the study inputs to manufacture as well as the products were analysed from the REACH Regulation point of view, liabilities and obligations were determined and solutions and processes to assure compliance were recommended to the client. Also several hundred MSDS were revised and corrected to match the REACH Regulation requirements.
